



## Conflict Materials Policy Statement

Per the Dodd-Frank Act, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) has adopted rules requiring publicly traded companies to disclose whether they use tantalum, tin, gold and tungsten (3TG) that originated in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (and adjoining countries) in the products they produce.

Allcom Products is committed to providing "Conflict Free" products to our customer base. Conflict Free is defined as not containing 3TG that directly or indirectly finances or benefits armed groups in the DRC or an adjoining country.

Allcom is committed to assuring that its suppliers are in compliance with this directive by requesting them to provide documentation/certification that all 3TG materials are Conflict Free.

Allcom currently purchases products from you that may contain 3TG minerals. As such, we are requesting that you complete the included Conflict Materials Supplier Certification and the EICCGeSIDD template. Please return the certification and template to us no later than 12/31/13.

If your company currently has a Conflict Materials Policy/Program in place and use a standardized certification, you may use your own certification in place of the included certification.
